We would like to invite you to be involved in the next All Ford Day South Australia event to be held on Sunday 17th October 2021. Entries will open from 6pm Friday 6th August 2021.

Thanks to you, other past entrants, our sponsors and contributors, All Ford Day SA has been a great success, with many visitors coming out to see the variety of Ford manufactured vehicles on display.

After not being able to hold the event in 2020 due to COVID restrictions we are excited and looking forward to the 2021 event, pending the COVID Management Plan approval by SA Health.

In 2021 we will be celebrating Ford "Through the Decades" that will focus on the many different shapes and sizes of Ford vehicles in the past 118 years of Ford releases. We are also excited to be moving to a new location at Oakbank Racecourse in the Adelaide Hills. Over the past few years, the event has more than doubled in size and our new location will allow us the space we need to continue to grow and allow for more cars on display, as well as providing additional space for the new requirements that COVID brings.

As per previous years the event will be open for entrant setup from 7:30am with the gates to be open to the public between 10am and 4pm.

Entries:

Due to COVID requirements we are requesting that this year <u>all entries be made through our online booking system</u> which accepts both credit card and PayPal payment methods.

Please follow this link to enter from 6pm Friday 6th August 2021: AFD Online Entry

Entries will open from <u>6pm Friday 6th August 2021</u> and <u>pre-entries will remain open until Friday 1st October</u>. This year we have introduced an additional option to enter for Display Only (non-judged), this has a reduced entry fee for those that would like to enter to display but not have their vehicle judged. If you have any questions or are unable to enter using the online system, please contact the AFD team directly for an alternative option.

Judged pre-entries will be \$30 for the first car and \$25 for each additional car (must be owned by the same person). The first 400 vehicles entered will receive a commemorative medallion and goody bag to be collected on the day of the event.

All entry information will also be available via our website, please feel free to distribute to others as well: www.allfordday.net.au

Late Entries:

After the pre-entry closes, late entries will <u>ONLY be accepted via our Late Entry Online booking</u> system. Due to COVID requirements, <u>late entries will NOT be accepted on the day</u> at the venue as has been done in the past. Late Entry will be open until the day before the event, closing at <u>12pm Saturday 16th October 2021</u>. Late entries will be subject to a \$10 Late Entry surcharge, will NOT be eligible for judging and will be required to park in the Late Entry Area.

COVID Requirements:

For contact tracing purposes anyone attending the event will be required to utilise the South Australian Government COVID SAfe QR Check-in system upon arrival to the venue (or the backup paper log). Please be prepared to present your check-in at the entry gate. All Ford Day SA reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone that does not comply with these requirements in accordance with our COVID Management Plan - No check-in, No Entry.

As with previous years, the 2021 event will have lots of great raffles, trade stalls and trophies for entrants on the day.



Late in 1992, as I was returning home, I passed a Newsagency which had the latest addition of *Wheels* plastered across the front window. The cover featured the return of the Falcon GT, the EB, in Black Pearl, occupying prime position on the cover of the October edition of *Wheels*. I quickly parked my Father's Warm Grey, XF Falcon S Pack station wagon and raced in to secure my copy.

Prior to this, I had already previewed the coming 25th Anniversary Falcon GT at that year's Melbourne International Motor Show. I can recall standing in front of Ford's newest Grand Tourer, rotating behind a chrome barrier, wanting to find out more and just hoping, I would be able to own and drive such a beast.....which finally occurred in 2005.

The EB and following EL GT (launched as the 30th Anniversary in 1997), the Tickford era, generated overwhelmingly positive reports from motoring journalists at the time of each GTs release. Not so from some Ford enthusiasts, recalling memories of GT-HOs. Descriptions varied from: exceptional handling not experienced in an Australian performance car before, representative of a true Grand Tourer; to disappointment, with power not representative of past GTs and GT-HOs which, let us not forget, were built for the sole purpose of winning Bathurst. So the question of performance is always raised when discussion occurs on the comparison with past and Tickford era GTs. Howard Marsden steered the development of the EB GT, and made a point of mentioning they were not building a race car, but a *Grand Tourer*, in the truest sense, a 'Gentlemen's Express'.



Howard Marsden, the same guy that managed the Phase III racing program, oversaw Moffat's crushing victory at Bathurst in 1971 and headed the Phase IV program, (that is him with a winged sump) envisioned a refined, modern, luxury GT, fit for the 90's performance car enthusiast. Ford's newly reintroduced 5.0L Windsor V8 powering the EB II was the start point.

The EB II Falcon GT featured the 5.0L Windsor sourced from the Mustang Cobra R. Advertised at 200kw (270 bhp), it was the first time since the XB GT a Ford had developed that type of power and, for comparison, the BMW M5 (the fastest 4 door production car in 1992) developed (only) 250 kw and cost considerably more at \$153,000, over twice as much as the GT at \$62,500 (adjusted to inflation, the EB GT would have cost \$121,189.98 in today's coin). 400m times recorded by Wheels had the EB GT (manual) covering the distance in 15.2 sec.......the last recorded time for a (standard) XB GT was 16.5sec (ignoring the GT-HO). The very last 5.8L XE ESP in 1982 was slower again.

As the times suggest, progress from the XB GT was evident; however, as the EB and EL (which was quicker again, 14.9 sec -400m and further refined) failed to eclipse the Phase III, or were too far refined in the modern sense of performance delivery, that left the Tickford GTs open to criticism.

Performance in the 90's and today, cost money. If Howard Marsden chose to build a GT-HO (which he very well could have), the performance gain would have contributed to a very expensive retail.....comparing to the M5's new car price, which was delivering HO levels of acceleration. The critical gain in performance with the Tickford GTs was not so much under the bonnet, but "from the Wheels Up!" (if I may quote an old piece of Falcon advertising for the XW....or was it XY??). Handling had become the key Option!!





I for one can state, the handling of an EB GT would eclipse any local product built prior to,.... on any race track. Bold statement I know; however, just ask the drivers of all the chrome bumpered cars from the AMCR in 2019.....what the back of GT 0223 looks like!.....as the superior handling of the EB GT allowed my meagre skill as a driver, maintain a good pace against much larger capacity, heavily modified Muscle Cars, much to their surprise. Ford poured a significant amount of the GT development budget onto something that was a suggestion on past GTs,....Handling, and started with the best performance tyres at the time, Pirelli's P Zero Assimetricos. These were 'original equipment' on Ferrari's F-40 and featured on the EB GT; as a result, I did enjoy cruising around Phillip Island Grand Prix Track, with the climate control set (exactly) to 20 C, overtaking traffic on the outside of Siberia, in leather and walnut comfort...a true 'Gentlemen's Express'. I even applied the indicator, in order to be a considerate.......Gentleman that is....

Luxury is what you get when you enter an EB or EL GT. Leather featured in both and strips of walnut (real walnut, that's wood,...from a tree by the way... in the EB) adorned both. MOMO steering wheels (everything had to be MOMO back then) and all the 'bells and whistles' Ford had at the time, makes for a very comfortable driving experience and the best interiors Ford has created,.....in my opinion.

As a proud owner, I can never see myself selling GT 0223. It is still a capable driving machine (*maybe not the* <u>Ultimate</u> <u>driving machine......BM...something...Unicorn</u>) and delivers satisfaction on any twisty road. Modern hatch backs today may be able to out accelerate it (that would apply for the chrome bumper GTs as well); however, as it is a GT, (because the badge Ford put on the back says it is!) that is all that matters to me.


