

#### Proposal 3

Delete current and re-write as -

22.1 The assets and income of the FGTCSA must be applied solely in furtherance of its objectives, and no portion shall be distributed directly or indirectly to its Members, except as a bona fide:

- (a) Compensation for services rendered; or
- (b) Expenses incurred on behalf of the FGTCSA.

22.2 Any bank account held by the FGTCSA with a balance over \$500 must be operated as a two(2) signatory account. Bank accounts with balances up to \$500 may be operated as a single signatory account.

(a) Single signatory account balances may only be replenished by a motion at a General meeting that is seconded and passed by those present.

22.3 All accounts are to be paid by EFT or cheque upon the Treasurers receipt of invoice/s.

22.4 No two(2) Financial Members who are first degree relatives(including defacto relationships)or living in the same household can be signatories of any account held by the FGTCSA.






