Unicorn and I were privileged to attend the 2020 Adelaide 500, enjoying the then new Mustang dominating early that season. ## **Matters Arising:**

- *New club application – Falcon GT & Ford Performance Club of Northern NSW – no representative, so no further progress.*
- *Gary advised that there had been consultation with Mark over the items to purchase for judging. Covid put things on hold. The only thing we hadn't decided was the type of light. From the meeting, the agreement was a to go with the sample Mark had from Supercheap. Also, would only need a couple of paint gauges and cameras. Suggestion to go for paint gauges to have the sensor on a cord.*
- *Mark advised that he was progressing with the trialling of tablets for judging and would trial it with one or two categories at Bathurst.*

## **Agenda Items:**

### **Inverell Club:**

*Gary asked the question about the Inverell Club. Is the Inverell Sporties Club a new club or the Inverell RSM club with a new name. Gary has sent 3 emails to the club asking for clarification however, has not heard back.*

*The delegates present advised that the Falcon GT and Ford Performance Club had realigned and now were associated with the Inverell Sporties Club and no longer part of RSM.*

### **Tasmanian Club:**

*Suggested penalty for entering modified modern with less than the minimum 4 modifications needed to suffice the category – two options: A) 10 point penalty or B) only eligible for Silver Awards.*

## **Category Name**

*Mark B and Tony K noted that Modern Modified doesn't make sense as such, in the previous category, with most changes being "bolt on" rather than engineered and some changes can go unnoticed compared to an unrestored car.*

*Suggestion that Contemporary Modern is more appropriate as a category name.*

*The key point for this category is to clearly define the difference between a stock car and modified/contemporary.*

*Mark B moved a motion to change the working from Modern Modified, to Contemporary Modern.*

*Adrian P seconded the motion, Passed.*

## **Penalty points for Contemporary Modern:**

*Discussion held that if a car is entered in Contemporary Modern, and doesn't suffice the minimum changes, the penalty should rule them out of the winning of such category  
A 100 point correct options bonus is issued to a car if they suffice the minimum requirements of such category, in Contemporary Modern, if such car fails to meet the minimum 4 modifications, the 100 point correct option bonus will not be given*

*Con A – discussed cars jumping categories especially with paint. e.g. maintained cars dropping back to unrestored, and penalties should apply to such cars*

*David W – The entrants must be aware, and also within the Nationals guidelines that if your car is entering in the wrong category, that the 100-point correct options bonus will not be applied*

*Mark B – moved that the entrant must have their car entered in the correct category at the time of scrutineering. The 100-point correct options bonus will be awarded for every car that is in the correct class and suffices the minimum requirement of such categories.*

*Adrian P seconded the motion – passed.*

*Con A/Mick S – suggested copies of the judging guidelines to be made available at scrutineering for the entrant to read, after feedback for the judges i.e. wrong class*

*Tim M – Unrestored cars paint thickness, a judge will be ready to inspect such cars with the paint thickness tool*

*Darryl M – suggested judging guidelines to be made available, in the form of a notice board for the entrants, throughout the event. (Possibly using QR codes? Mark B?)*

*Adrian reminded all in attendance to put their phone on silent, and when discussing issues to raise your hand, and to state your name and club to assist in the meeting minutes.*

## **Minimum kms on cars**

*Mark B – Classic Era Platinum exceeds 95% points, and there are next to no cars with minimal kms on them in the classic era.*

*With Modern Platinum, this is very common and the current guidelines for minimal kms needs to be clearly defined.*

*Tim M – asked where does the Platinum/Gold area start A: 8000km or more km on the current system.*

*Con A – discussed where the cut-off date/time should be for the minimum km for Modern Era. Currently it is 15yrs/15,000km.*

*Mark B – The platinum cars will only compete against other platinum cars, same for the gold class*

*Nick Z – Presentation of the cars should be paramount compared to kms.*

*David W – the platinum cars must comply to the movement as such, rather than change the guidelines to suit such low km cars and non GT enthusiasts.*

*Mark B – moved to introduce a new platinum class for the modern era for all cars below the qualifying km limit, that achieve the 95% judging cut-off at scrutineering. - passed*

*Remove the minimum 15yr requirements for modern era cars - passed*

*Apply the km rule to separate the platinum and gold categories from the last Falcon GT built in 2014, which applies to all modern era Falcon GT, 1000km per year up to 15000km – passed.*

## **Grand Tourer Modern Era Award**

*Tony K – asked should Platinum cars be eligible for the Grand Tourer Modern Award?*

*After some discussion proposed that Grand Tourer Modern to go to only Gold Cars – passed.*
