To the Members of The Falcon GT Club of South Australia Inc

THE FALCON GT CLUB OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA INC

I have reviewed the information provided to me, by the Treasurer, which included bank statements, invoices and receipts relating to The Falcon GT Club of South Australia Inc ('the Club') for the year ended 30 June 2022.

The financial position of the Club as at 30 June 2022, comprising of bank and investment accounts held with Beyond Bank were evidenced by sighting bank statements and viewing the balances online.

The income and expenditure for the year ended 30 June 2022 was reviewed with all income agreeing to the bank statements of the Club and material expenditure transactions being agreed to supporting invoices and receipts on a sample basis.

I noted that the information presented is on the cash basis of accounting and is for the period 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022.

Qualification

Membership subs income is a significant source of income for the Club. It currently is deemed impractical to establish control over the membership subs income prior to its entry into the financial records.

Accordingly, as the evidence available to me regarding income from this source was limited, my procedures with respect to membership subs income were restricted to amounts recorded in the financial records. I am therefore unable to provide a view on whether the recorded membership subs income is complete.

I will be providing a summary of recommendations to strengthen the Club's internal control environment in due course.

Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto Mann Rd

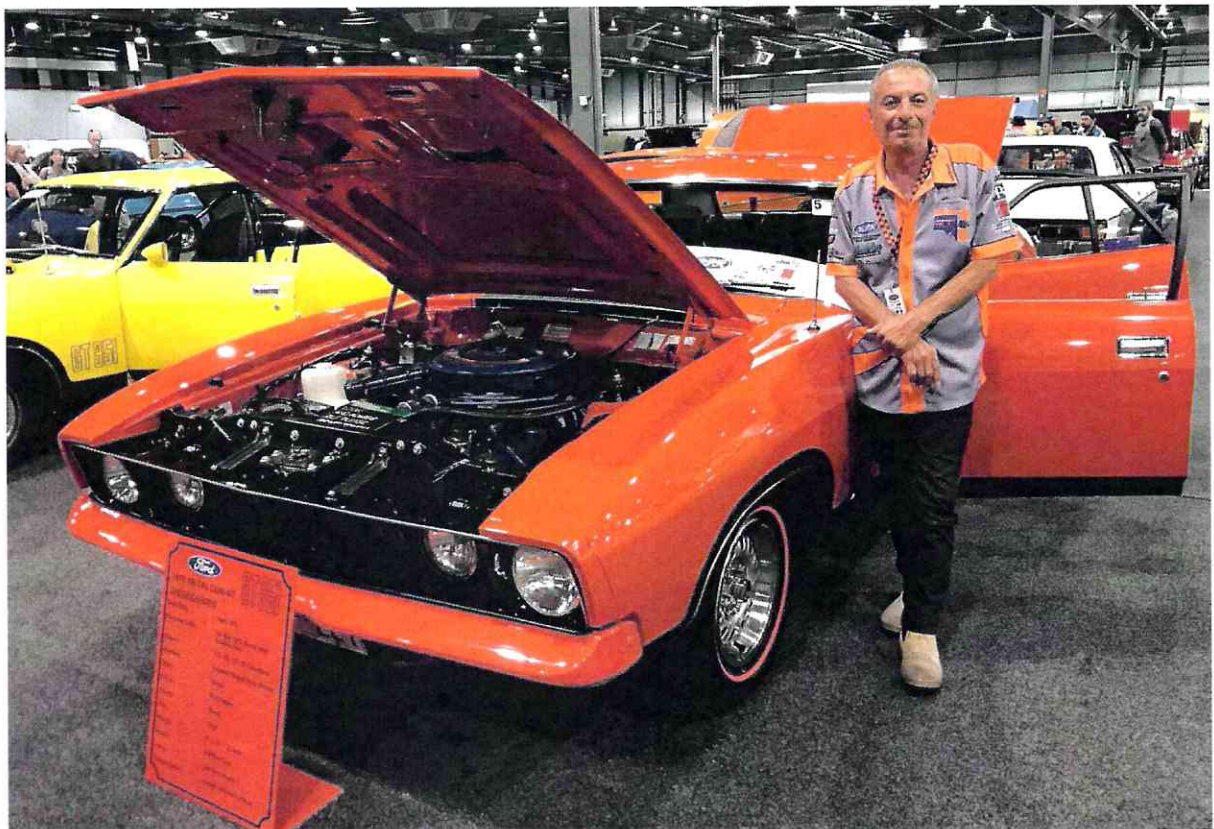

Details of Dad's battle with Cancer:

On the 16th August, 2021, 5 months after retiring, Dad was diagnosed with an extremely rare form of cancer in the stomach lining (named Peritoneal cancer).

This cancer is typically only found in the advanced stages and in Dad's case, was only identified during keyhole surgery after multiple CT scans and X-rays provided inconclusive results. Doctors were surprised with how advanced the cancer was given symptoms only began in early June. Dad was given two weeks to live.

Dad fought the nasty disease for six months, where he endured multiple chemotherapy treatments, hospital visits and a cocktail of medications. Towards the end, the cancer progressed and caused the first part of the small intestine to narrow, preventing him from being able to eat. He didn't eat for over 4 weeks.

Throughout all this, Dad didn't complain once and the doctors were always surprised to see how strong he was and knew he wouldn't give up without a fight.

Dad lost his battle with the deadly disease on the 5th March 22.

Details of Dad's battle with Cancer:

On the 16th August, 2021, 5 months after retiring, Dad was diagnosed with an extremely rare form of cancer in the stomach lining (named Peritoneal cancer).

This cancer is typically only found in the advanced stages and in Dad's case, was only identified during keyhole surgery after multiple CT scans and X-rays provided inconclusive results. Doctors were surprised with how advanced the cancer was given symptoms only began in early June. Dad was given two weeks to live.

Dad fought the nasty disease for six months, where he endured multiple chemotherapy treatments, hospital visits and a cocktail of medications. Towards the end, the cancer progressed and caused the first part of the small intestine to narrow, preventing him from being able to eat. He didn't eat for over 4 weeks.

Throughout all this, Dad didn't complain once and the doctors were always surprised to see how strong he was and knew he wouldn't give up without a fight.

Dad lost his battle with the deadly disease on the 5th March 22.

Saturday 25 February

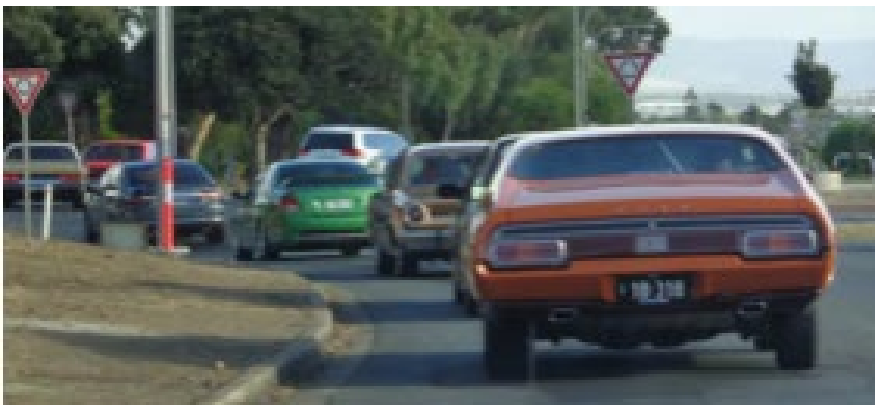
Hi everyone,
