Vehicles cannot be used with logbooks that are not current, with the risk being of incurring a fine for an unregistered vehicle.

Please supply a stamped, self addressed return envelope for prompt return of logbooks.

The club is required, by law, to notify DIT of club members who haven't renewed their membership.


January we always have Micks midweek cruise so keep an eye on the fb page.
