Not sure if any of you check out the European races, as a little known event called the Le Mans 24h was run recently, and a Ford Mustang GT3 made it on the podium on its maiden attempt, coming third in it's class, which, over a race like Le Mans, is no small feat! It is great to see the Ford hierarchy getting enthusiastic about racing Mustang in such a high profile event, which of course, Ford won with the Ford GT (again, against Ferrari!) in 2016, as all the other 'pony cars' expire.

Once again, the GM and Dodge appliances have failed to survive the pounding of so many hooves tramping them into the tar, whilst we look forward to what is next. It's not a Falcon; however, a performance car with a V8 engine is likely to come from Ford for quite some time yet, as stated by Bill Ford, the great-grandson of company founder Henry, vowed to keep the V8 engine under the bonnet of the Mustang for as long as allowed by government regulators around the world.

"I love the V8s, but you know, we will progress as the world moves on, but I'd like us to keep the V8 as long as possible and we will," he said.

Right now, a V8 Mustang can be had as a GT, a GT3 and the hyper car GTD. The possibilities of Ford also bringing back past heroes, such as the Boss and Mach 1 branding, even the Bullitt remain possibilities. So long as the Mustang's beating heart feeds on the remains of dead dinosaur, screaming at 7000 rpm on all eight of its cylinders, the world should retain what little motoring fun remains, and allow some individualism above the sea of white and grey EV, SUV, that litter the roads today.

Open to all car clubs and members to spend a day at the Dragway running down the ¼ mile and having some fun. See who has the fastest speed as part of our brand new product we are calling – Car Club Speed Challenge.

#### Here is how it works:

- 1. Rolling start, with take off speed measured between guard beam and the 60 foot beam. Your speed between these points can't be faster than 50 KPH. If you travel faster than 50 KPH through that trap your run will be disqualified (Like red lighting in a drag race)
- 2. Once past the 60 ft beam you go flat to the floor and run as fast as you can though the finish line.
- 3. The winner is determined by the fastest speed. You will receive a time slip that gives you all the speeds your vehicle travelled from start to 330ft, 660ft, and 1320ft.

This is as much fun as you can have with your clothes on! No stress on vehicles as its not from a standing start and gives you a chance to see how fast your car will go in a safe legal environment.

**The Deal:** single club or join with other clubs to make the numbers up.

**Entries:** minimum 70 to 80 vehicles required for speed challenge.

**Cost:** \$100 per vehicle includes Day license, Personal accident insurance. Passengers can ride in the vehicle alongside you all day for \$30.

Vehicle/driver requirements: Open to all road registered cars, pass a basic vehicle safety check on the day. Driver will require an in-date helmet, long sleeves, long pants, enclosed shoes. Passengers will require the same.

Time: Gates open 9am

Vehicle safety check and sign in: 9am - 11am

Session 1 speed challenge: 11am - 1pm

Lunch: 1pm – 2pm, Sausage sizzle will be

provided as part of the day.

Session 2: 2pm – 4pm( includes elimination runs

to find the ultimate winner)

**Prizes:** Fastest speed of the day at 660ft and 1320ft. Overall winner of the elimination challenge.

Spectating: No cost to just come and watch


